## The Flag of the United Kingdom



The Flag of the United Kingdom (the Union Jack) is the national flag of the United Kingdom.

It consists of the red cross of St. George (patron saint of England), superimposed on the Cross of St. Patrick (patron saint of Ireland), which are superimposed on the Saltire of St. Andrew (patron saint of Scotland).

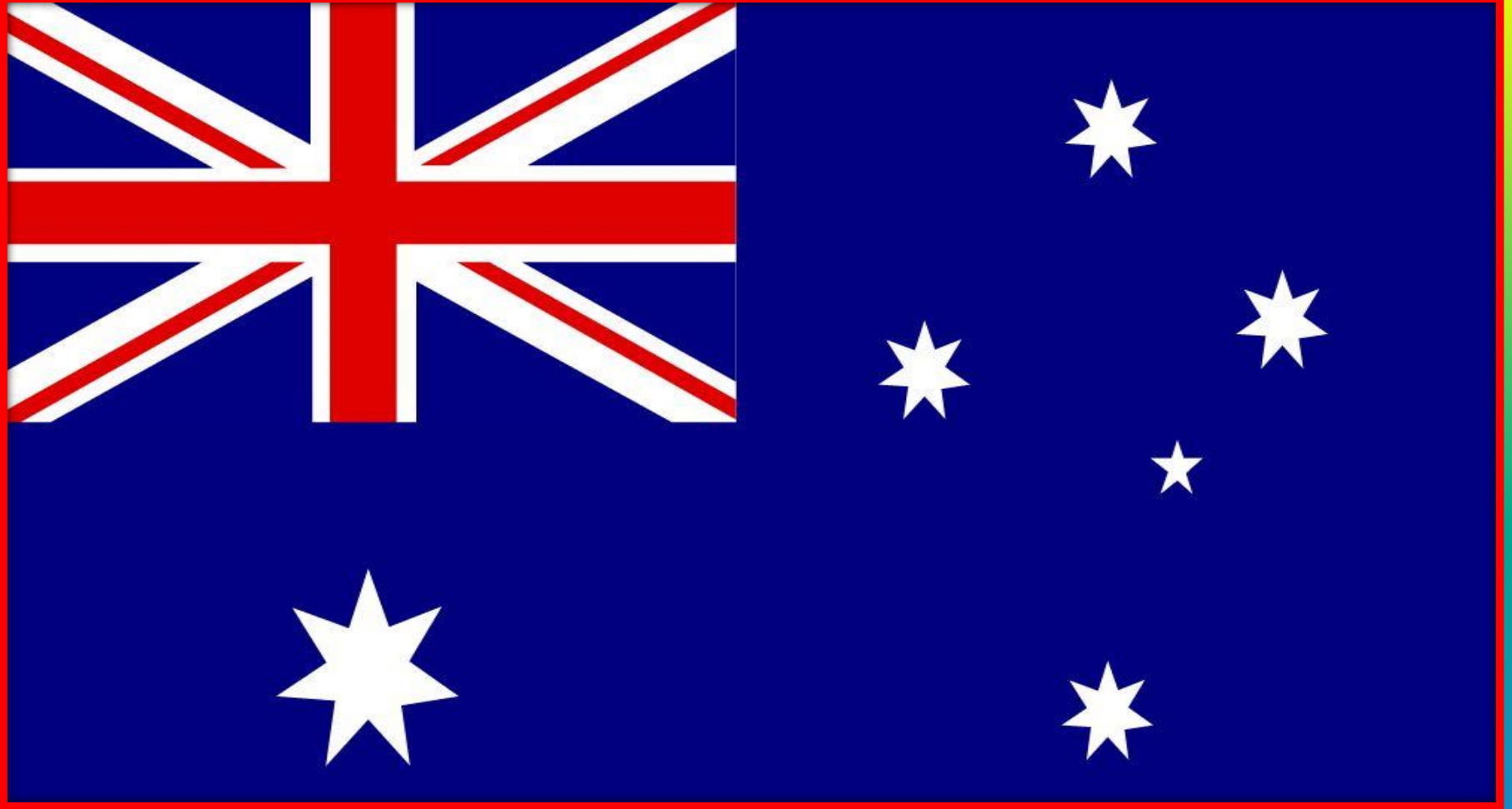




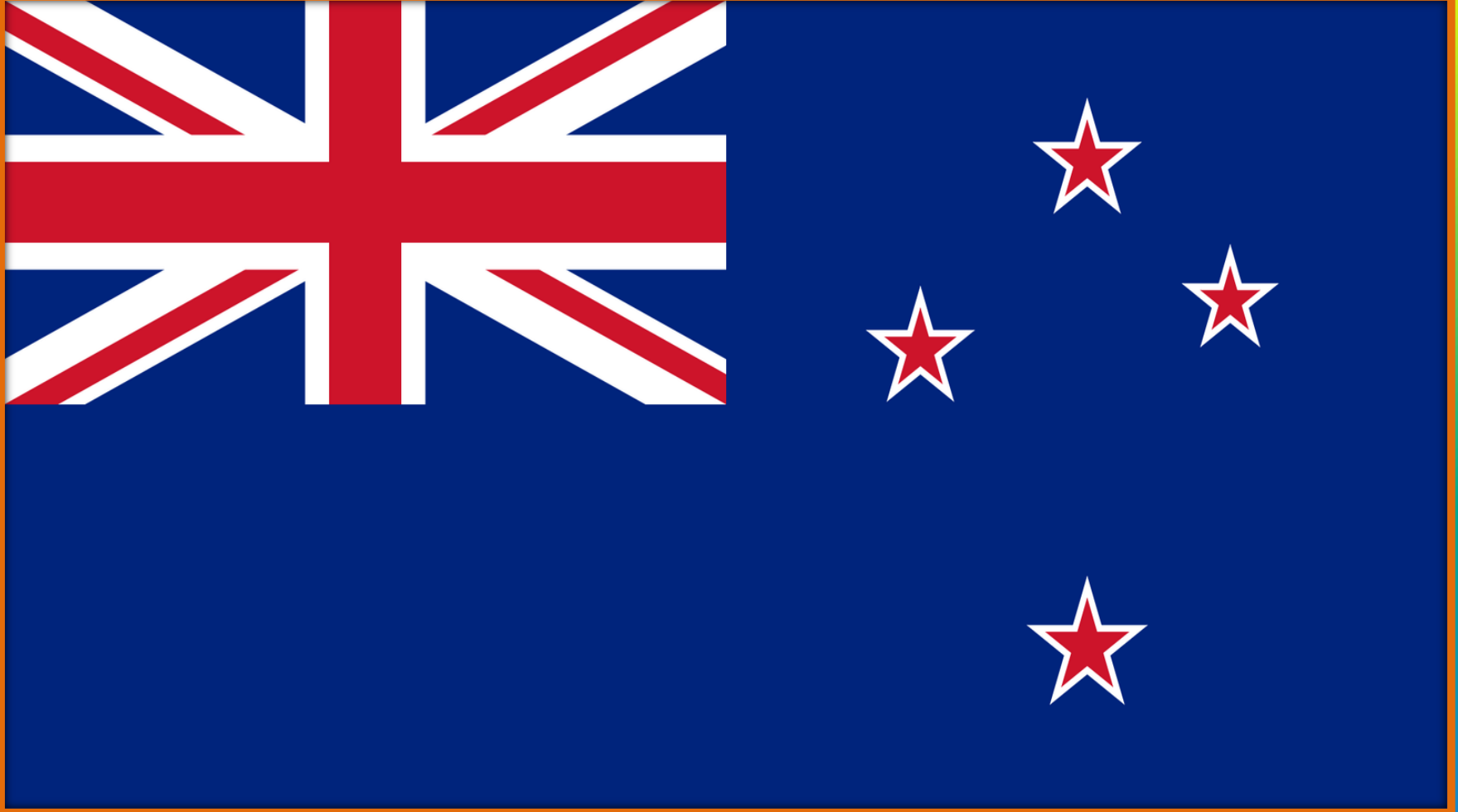

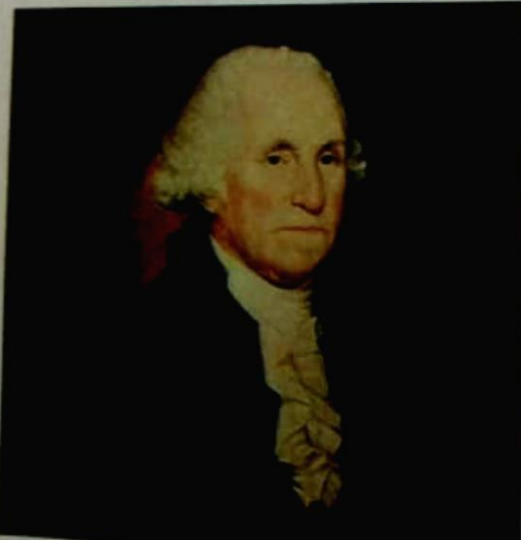

# Present perfect.

## present perfect: affirmative and negative

We use the present perfect to talk about experiences in the past, when we don't mention the exact time.

**subject** + **have / has** + **past participle**

+	I've tried rock climbing. He's run a marathon. They've become famous.
-	I haven't seen a flying dog! He hasn't tried parachuting. They haven't missed an opportunity for adventure.

've = have    's = has

haven't = have not    hasn't = has not

# Grammar



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## Tenses (Грамматические времена)

1. Как вы уже знаете, о событиях прошлого можно рассказать, используя времена *past simple* [ $V_{ed} / V_2$ ] или *present perfect* [ $have/has + V_3$ ]. Выбор одной из этих глагольных форм часто зависит от маркеров, используемых в предложении.

<b>Past Simple</b> (известно, когда и часто где произошло событие)	<b>Present Perfect</b> (не известно или неважно, когда произошло событие, важен результат в настоящем)
yesterday (evening, morning) then ago last (в последний раз) last year (month, week) the other day (на днях) the day before yesterday (позавчера) just now	ever already never yet this year (month, week) this morning (evening, afternoon) lately just
I saw him 3 days ago. We played tennis the other day. Did you meet him last week? When did you talk to him last?	I have already seen him. We have never played tennis. Have you met him this week? Have you talked to him yet?

2. Обратите внимание на различия в использовании маркеров **just** и **just now**.

**just** — маркер времени *present perfect*      I have just done it.

**just now** — маркер времени *past simple*      I did it just now.

3. С указателями **this morning**, **this afternoon**, **this evening** употребляются оба времени: *past simple* и *present perfect*.

Выбор времени зависит от того, закончилось ли утро (полдень или вечер) в тот момент, когда происходит разговор.

Сравните: I saw him this morning. (Разговор происходит после 12 часов дня. Утро закончилось.)

I have seen him this morning. (Разговор происходит утром, до 12 часов дня. Утро ещё не закончилось.)

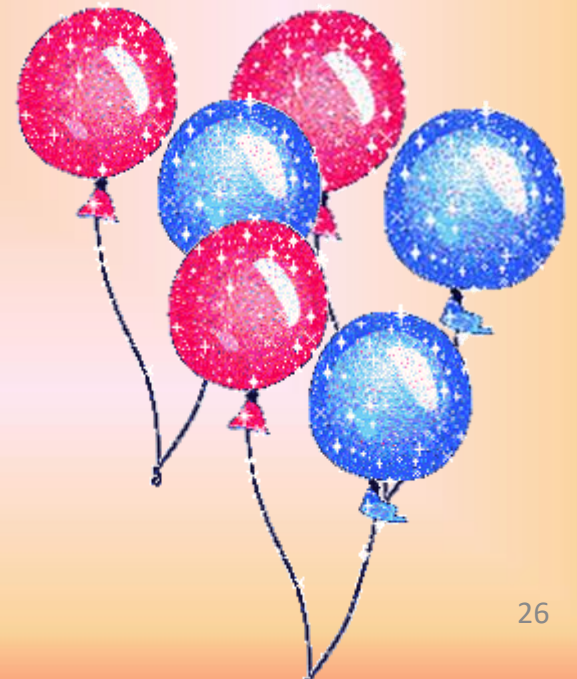

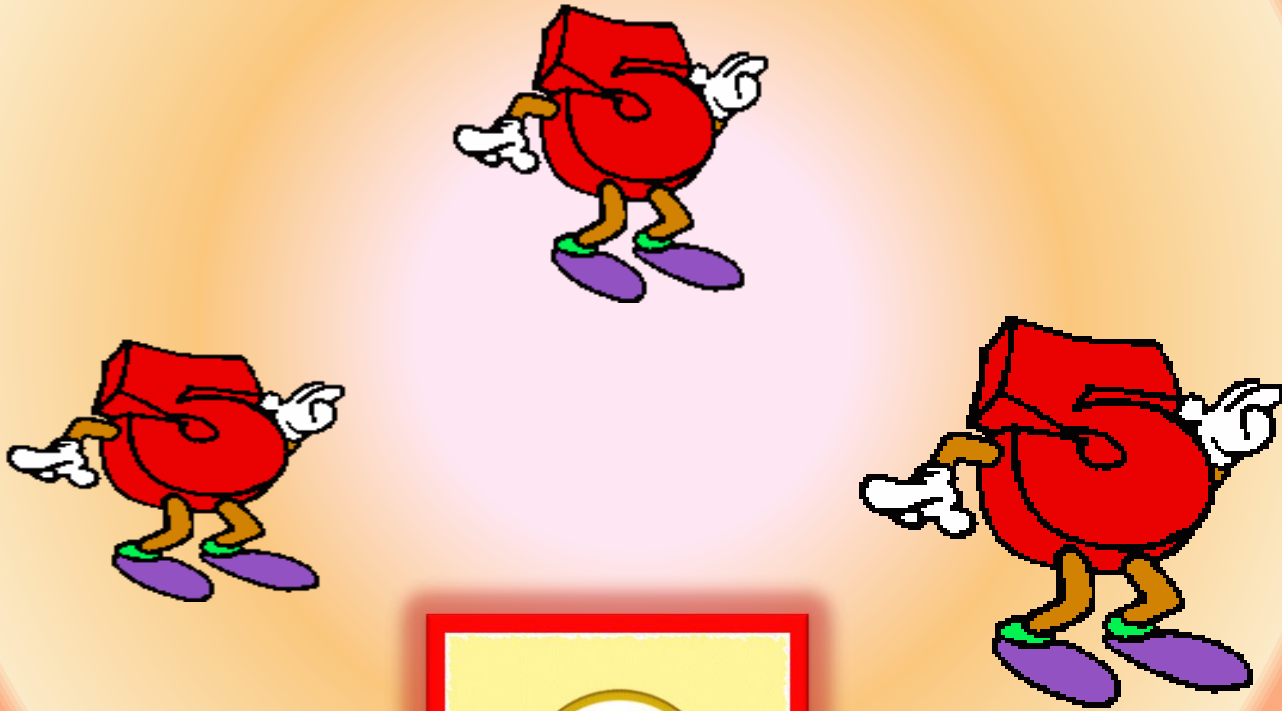
