## Present perfect.

#### present perfect: affirmative and negative

We use the present perfect to talk about experiences in the past, when we don't mention the exact time.

subject + have / has + past participle

- I've tried rock climbing.
- He's run a marathon.
   They've become famous.
  - I haven't seen a flying dog!
- He hasn't tried parachuting.
  - They haven't missed an opportunity for adventure.

've = have 's = has haven't = have not hasn't = has not

Утро закончилось.)

I have seen him this morning. (Разговор происходит утром, до 12 часов дня. Утро ещё не закончилось.)
